Mayme is the grandmother in-law of Jane Cornue who is a long time member of our Chapter. Mayme was a Milliner for Chicago's society ladies creating hats to match their gowns. No hats to show, but samples of Mayme's intricate quilling. She was a lady ahead of the times, and a photographer. Jane created her presentation about Mayme for the DAR and has offered to share it with us. Her presentation includes embroidered linens made by Mayme for her hope chest, honeymoon photos taken by Mayme and the leather photo album Mayme assembled. Jane will have Needlework magazines from the 1903- 1924 that shows the beading and embroidery for ladies attires for the time period. This will be a walk through history and promises to be of interest to all.


