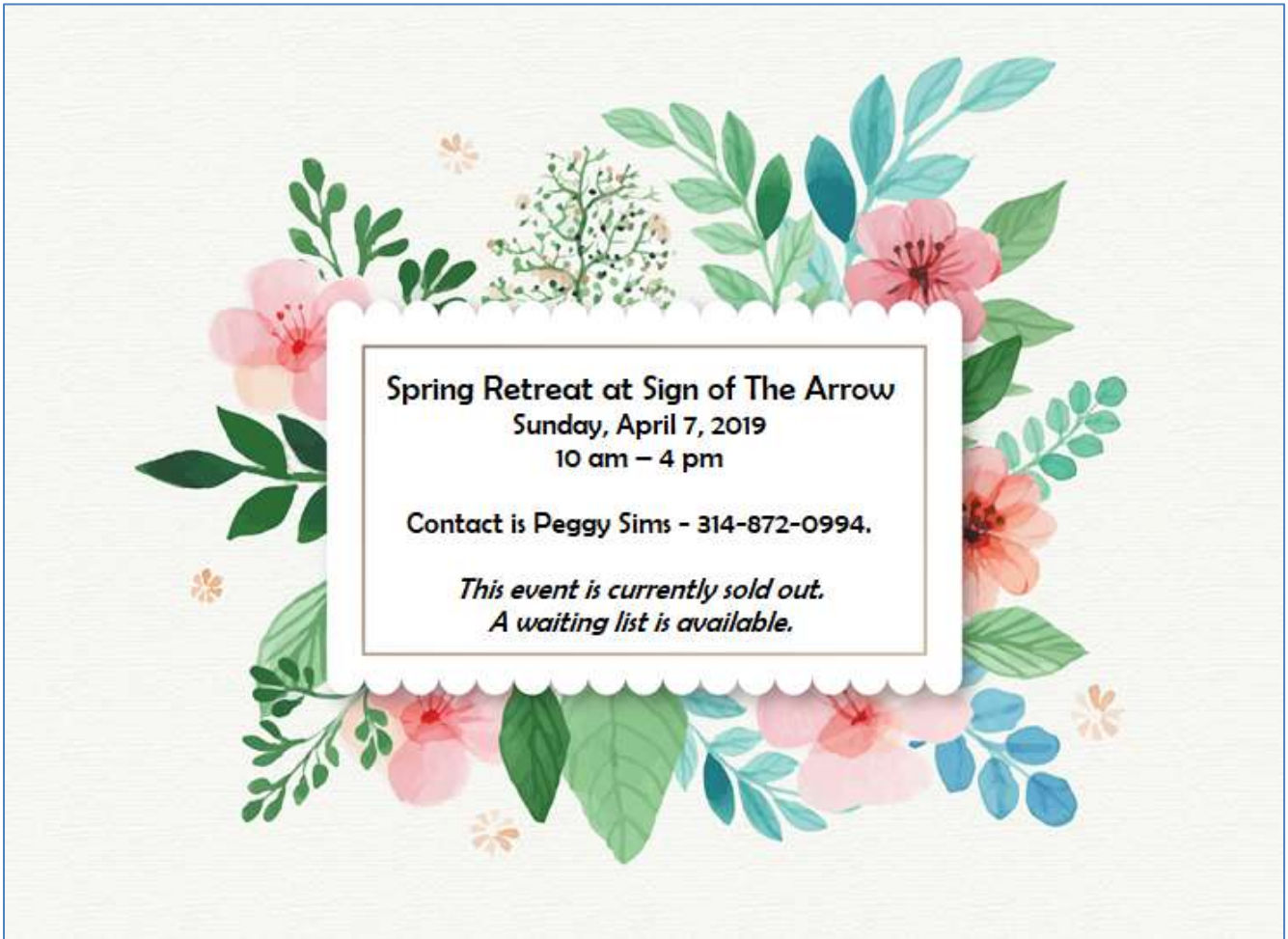
Memberships News
